VISITATION CENTER

FAMILY BASKETS/KITS

The Visitation Program coaches, mentors and teaches families different ways to interact and engage with their children. Many of our families are homeless, don't have stable jobs and may have substance abuse or mental health diagnosis. A starter bag or basket can go a long way towards helping these families get back on their feet. Our staff show them different resources that are available to them while mentoring them during their visits with their children. The staff work with them on ways to engage their children in age appropriate play, teaching them how to do various activities, discuss nutritious snacks and meals and teach the families different behavior management techniques.
